Cable trays are designed to support electrical, signal, and communication cables, but they do not inherently provide internal support for bundled cables. Without proper support, cables can sag, shift, or become stressed at connection points, which may lead to insulation damage, short circuits, or fire hazards (Cable Tray Institute, CMW) . Overfilled or unsupported trays can also cause excessive heat buildup, increasing the risk of insulation breakdown and electric shock (Cable Tray Company) .

NEC and Industry Guidelines

According to NEC Article 392, cables must be secured at intervals and fastened to transverse members for non-horizontal runs. Supports must prevent stress where cables enter raceways, and cable ties or other securement devices must be listed and suitable for the environment (Nassau National Cable) . Vertical and horizontal trays have the same fill requirements, and proper support is essential for long-term integrity (Cable Tray Institute) .

Solutions for Bundling and Support

To address the lack of internal supports, consider the following:

- **Cable Organizers and Dividers:** Use physical barriers or dividers to separate power, data, and control cables within the tray, preventing tangling and uneven weight distribution (Automation Forum) .
- **Cable Ties, Clips, or Velcro Straps:** Secure cables at regular intervals to maintain organization and reduce sagging. Velcro straps are recommended for data cables to avoid damage and facilitate maintenance (CMW) .
- **Mid-Span Supports:** For long spans or heavy cables, add additional supports beneath the tray or at intermediate points to prevent drooping (CMW) .
- **Tray Covers:** In areas exposed to environmental hazards, covers can protect cables and maintain proper airflow, reducing overheating risks (Automation Forum) .

Best Practices

- **Avoid overfilling trays;** adhere to NEC fill percentages to allow proper airflow and heat dissipation (Cable Tray Company) .
- **Remove abandoned or unused cables** to reduce clutter and maintain tray capacity (Cable Tray Company) .
- **Ensure grounding of the tray system** before cable installation to prevent arcing and enhance safety (Cable Tray Company) . By implementing these measures, cables inside a tray can remain organized, supported, and safe, reducing maintenance issues and extending the lifespan of the installation.
