

What are the industry color standards for optical cables



Overview

ANSI/TIA-598-C is the industry standard that defines color coding for optical fiber, buffer tubes, and fiber optic cables.

- Blue: Indoor polarization-maintaining fiber
- Other colors (e.g., RAL custom colors) may be used for in-building distribution or OEM identification).

Inner Fiber Color Sequence

Individual fibers within a cable are identified using a 12-color sequence for up to 12 fibers:

- Blue
 - Orange
 - Green
 - Brown
 - Slate
 - White
 - Red
 - Black
 - Yellow
 - Violet
 - Rose
- Aqua For cables with more than 12 fibers, the sequence repeats with black stripes added to maintain unique identification. In high-density cables, a tube-and-fiber system is used: the 12-color sequence is applied to the outer buffer tube and then to fibers inside the tube. For example, Fiber #34 in a 48-fiber cable would be the 10th fiber (Violet) in the 3rd tube (Green) .

Connector and Boot Colors

Connector colors indicate polish type and fiber mode:

- Blue: UPC single-mode
- Green: APC single-mode
- Beige: Multimode (OM1/OM2)
- Aqua: OM3/OM4 multimode
- Emerald Green: OM5 multimode These colors help technicians quickly identify the connector type and ensure proper mating .

Special Considerations

• 16-fiber MPO connectors use additional colors: 13: Olive, 14: Magenta, 15: Tan, 16: Lime.

• Custom jacket colors and printed legends can be used for project-specific identification, provided they comply with TIA standards .
