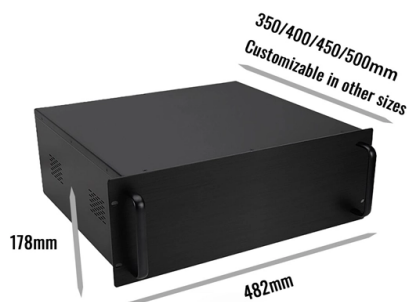


What does 24t mean on the core switch

The 24T designation points to 24 data ports, typically 10/100/1000 copper interfaces, while the A suffix refers to the Network Advantage software tier. That detail matters because this model is not simply a hardware choice. It is also a feature set decision.
