National Electrical Code (NEC) and UL 1277 standard, a Tray Cable is a factory-assembled, multi-conductor cable (two or more insulated conductors, with or without a grounding conductor) enclosed in a non-metallic overall jacket. Its core advantage is its approved. Tray cable (Type TC), is under NEC Article 336. This setup reduces the need for numerous conduit installations, significantly. All three of these cable types can be installed in cable tray. That's where the similarity ends. They're governed by different NEC articles, built to different UL standards, and permitted in different installation scenarios. Understanding those differences isn't academic. They are extensively deployed in manufacturing facilities, especially in process industries: petrochemical, steel, pulp and paper, cement and mining.
