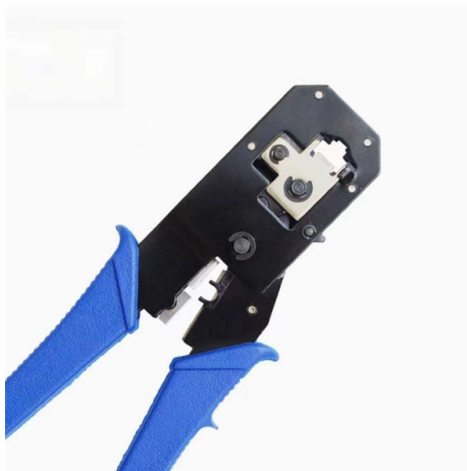


What is a network cable splitter

A network cable splitter, also called an Ethernet or LAN splitter, works by repurposing the unused wire pairs inside a standard Ethernet cable. Most Ethernet cables contain eight wires arranged in four twisted pairs, but slower 10/100 Mbps networks only use two pairs for data transmission. The splitter allocates the unused pairs to a second connection, effectively allowing two separate 10/100 Mbps signals to travel over a single cable. To function properly, a second splitter is required at the other end to separate the signals back into two distinct connections for the devices .

Practical Applications

Splitters are commonly used in situations where running additional cables is difficult or costly, such as in homes or offices with limited Ethernet drops. They are convenient for connecting two devices to a single wall outlet or router port without major network changes. This makes them useful for temporary setups, low-bandwidth environments, or small networks where devices are not heavily competing for data .

Limitations

- **Bandwidth Sharing:** A splitter does not multiply the available bandwidth; the two devices share the same cable capacity, which can reduce network speed .
- **Speed Restrictions:** Splitters are generally compatible only with 10/100 Mbps networks and are not suitable for Gigabit Ethernet, which uses all four wire pairs .
- **Two-Splitter Requirement:** Both ends of the cable must have a splitter to properly separate and merge signals; otherwise, the connection will not work .
- **Not a Switch:** Unlike a network switch, a splitter does not manage traffic or provide independent full-speed connections, so it is not a substitute for adding more ports to a network .
