Exceeding a cable's length limit leads to signal attenuation (loss), reduced bandwidth, and unreliable connectivity. They can connect routers, switches, firewalls and more network devices. The network cable is transmitting network signals. For most enterprise or data center applications using multimode fiber, the practical limit sits between 300 m and 550 m. Attenuation is the weakening of light as it comes in from the transmitting end of the fiber and out of the transmitting end.
