Fiber optic jumpers, also called patch cords, have connectors on both ends such as LC, SC, ST, FC, or MTP/MPO. To ensure proper connection:

- Match connector types: Use a jumper with the same connector type as the port on the tray (e.g., LC to LC, SC to SC) for direct connections between devices or patch panels .
- Check port labeling: Fiber optic trays and patch panels are usually labeled to indicate which port corresponds to which fiber or device. Plug the jumper into the port that aligns with the intended network path .



- Front vs. back connections: Typically, the front ports of the patch panel are used for jumper connections to devices, while the back ports connect to the main fiber distribution cables .

Special Considerations

- Duplex vs. simplex: Duplex jumpers have two fibers and are used for bidirectional communication. Ensure both fibers are connected to the correct transmit (TX) and receive (RX) ports .
- MTP/MPO jumpers: For high-density connections, MTP/MPO jumpers connect multiple fibers at once. Use the designated male or female port on the tray to match the jumper type .
- Terminal boxes: If connecting through a fiber optic terminal box, first connect the main fiber cable to the box, then plug the jumper into the corresponding port to reach the device .

- Locate the matching port on the front of the fiber optic tray or patch panel.
- Ensure proper orientation for duplex or MTP/MPO connections.
