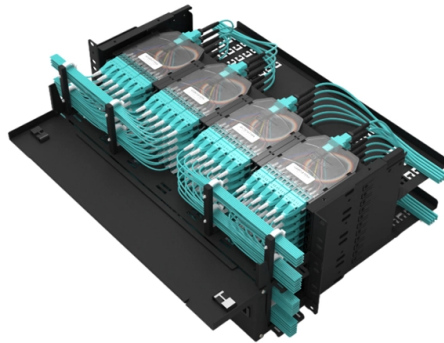


Which port should the optical attenuation module be plugged into
