Construction and Variants

Fiber optic cables typically include multiple layers for protection:

- **Core and Cladding:** The optical fiber itself, responsible for transmitting light signals.
- **Primary Coating:** A thin polymer layer protecting the fiber from microbends.
- **Buffer Tube (White Tube):** Encases one or more fibers, providing mechanical protection and flexibility.
- **Strength Members:** Aramid yarns (e.g., Kevlar) or rods to absorb tension.
- **Outer Jacket:** The external protective layer suitable for indoor or outdoor environments . The white tube may be tight-buffered for indoor distribution cables or loose-tube for outdoor or high-fiber-count cables, depending on the deployment scenario .
