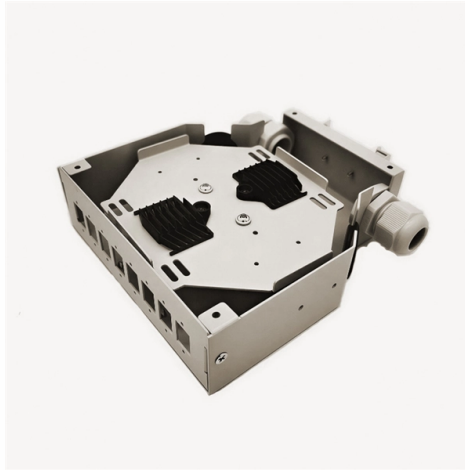

- **Cross-connect frames:** Structured patching in main distribution areas for enterprise or colocation environments.
- **FTTH and building entry:** Linking outside plant fiber to customer premise equipment.
- **Testing and measurement:** Connecting OTDRs, power meters, or light sources to active links during commissioning or troubleshooting .

Patch cords differ from pigtails, which have a connector on only one end and are typically fusion-spliced to backbone fibers, and from trunk cables, which are multi-fiber, long-distance cables used for permanent backbone connections .
